1. Visit the library website: <https://library.hkbu.edu.hk/>
2. Please log into [My Account] with your HKBU SSoid
3. Change the tab to [Database] and search with 'proquest'


4. Click [ProQuest] at the top of the results for opening ProQuest Platform

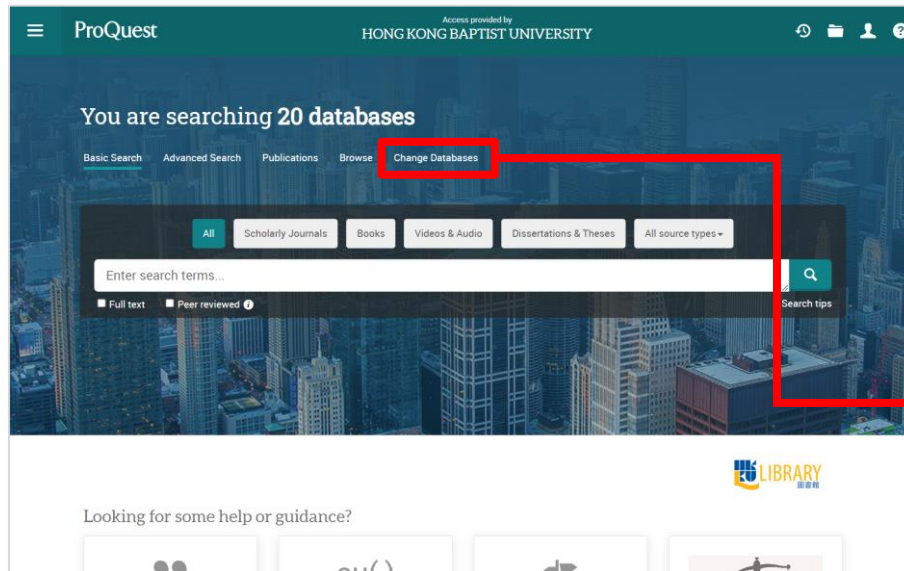

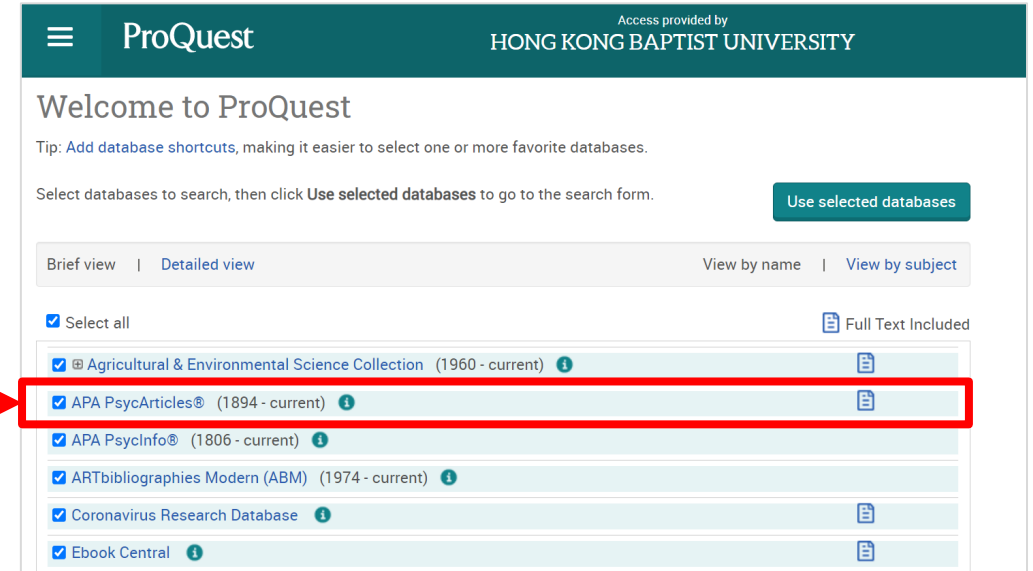
Difference between 'Platform' & individual 'Database'

- ProQuest is a useful academic information platform – its interface can cross-search different databases of subjects, newspapers, and scholarly journals, dissertations & theses together.
- However, the databases within ProQuest Platform can be selected and searched individually for using some **subject or content specific search functionality**.

Individual databases allow more specialized search !



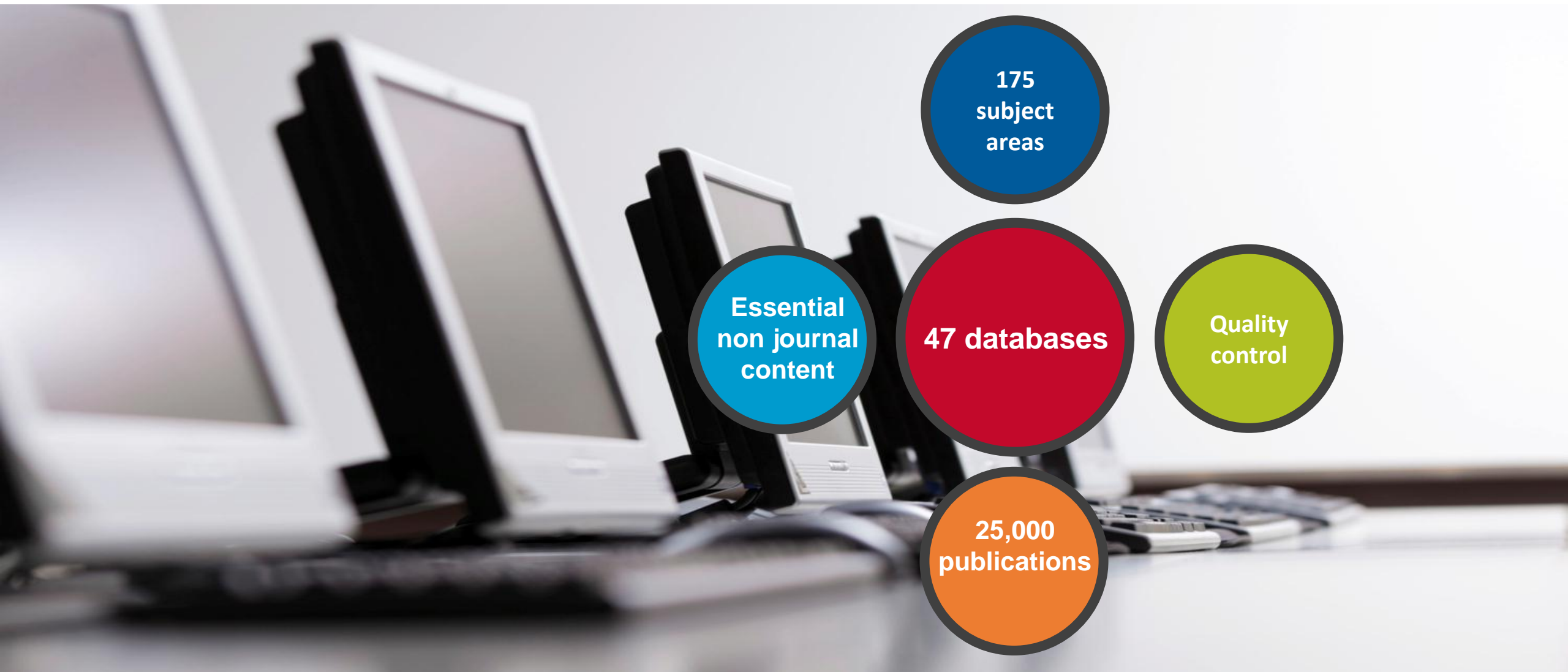

Abstract

This article uses a literature review about postponement, decoupling point and cold chain to offer alternatives for Brazilian distribution of refrigerated chicken. It was possible to conclude that a decoupling point between first and further industrialization can be a viable option for selling and distributing refrigerated chicken that has from seven to maximum of thirty days of shelf life.

Reverse innovation is not always either foreseeable or explicitly pursued by Western companies operating in emerging markets. 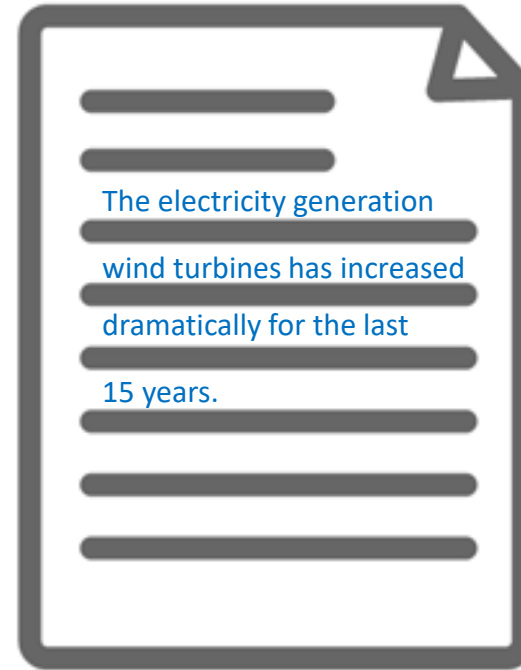
